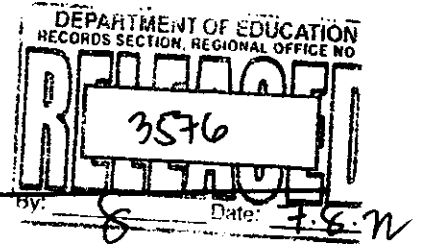

This is to formally invite your chapter to send representatives to the forthcoming 36th ASEAN COUNCIL OF TEACHERS + 1 (ACT+1) CONVENTION on September 2-4, 2022 at Mercure Hotels Convention Center Ancol in Jakarta, Indonesia, with the theme: *"Recovering from the Pandemic: Designing Post Pandemic Education in Digitally Infused World"*.

Attached as Annex A is a copy of the invitation letter from Dr. Unifah Rosyidi, President of the Teachers Association of the Republic of Indonesia/Persatuan Guru Republik Indonesia (PGRI), the host of this year's convention. For emphasis however, please find important convention details below:

- Inclusive Dates:** September 2-4, 2022
- Registration Fee:** 85 USD or roughly, Php 4,678.79 (based on current exchange rate)
**Instructions as to the manner/mode of payment will be relayed later*
- Accommodations:** The host highly recommends that delegates choose Mercure Hotel Ancol for accommodations as they have coordinated with the Management thereof for special rates to ACT+1 Delegates. For this purpose, we have attached as Annex B the Reservation Form for Mercure. The rates, email addresses where the duly accomplished form must be submitted including the August 15 deadline for the submission are all indicated in the form. Nonetheless, the delegates are not prohibited from securing accommodations at other hotels in Ancol.
- Transportation:** Transportation by groups from the airport to the hotel and vice-versa shall be arranged by the host.

- 7) Thailand : Teachers' Reskilling for Post Pandemic Learning


