Amendment to the Department Memoranders No. 2022-0206: "Interior Operational Guidelines on the Administration of 2nd COVID-19 Vaccine Bootter Doors to Senior Citizens and Frentillus Boothers Workers ages 18 years Old and Above"

On July 25, 2022, the Philippine Food and Drug Administration (FDA) expanded the Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) of certain COVID-19 vaccine brands to allow for their use as a second booster dose for individuals 50 years old and above and adults 18 to 49 years old with cosmorbidities. On July 26, 2022, the Health Technology Assessment Council (HTAC), after a thorough and expert review of the best available evidence, released their recommendation that the mRNA vaccines, Pfizer and Moderna, can be used as a second booster for individuals aged 50 years and older and in individuals aged 18 to 49 years old with comorbidities.

With this, Section IV. A. of Department Memorandum No. 2022-0296 deted May 18, 2022, otherwise known as, "Interim Operational Guidelines on the Administration of 2nd COVID-19 Vaccine Booster Doses to Senior Citizens and Frontline Healthcare Workers ages 18 years Old and Above" is hereby amended to expand the provision of second booster doses to include the following:

- s. All individuals 50 years old and above; and
- b. Adults 18 to 49 years old with comorbidities.

The second booster shall be administered at least 4 months after the 3rd dose or 1st booster. The vaccines to be inoculated shall include only the following COVID-19 vaccines granted with FDA EUA and HTAC recommendation: Tozinameran (Pfizer) and Spikevax (Moderna).

The decision to administer a second booster dose to patients with comorbidities shall be based on the risk-benefit assessment by the medical acrosser at the vaccination site. All implementing units shall be reminded to follow the vaccination process stipulated in the Administrative Order No. 2022-0005, otherwise known as the "Omnibus Guidelines on the

implementation of the National Deployment and Vaccination Plan for COVID-19 vaccines," and other relevant issuances.

All the provisions of Department Memorandum No. 2022-0206 dated May 18, 2022 not affected by this amendment shall remain valid and in effect.
