Reiterating the letter from Mr. Ian Gil Piencenaves, Regional Development Officer for Southeast Asia under the Badminton Asia (BA) and Badminton World Federation (BWF), re: Badminton Asia (BA) and Badminton World Federation (BWF) Coaching Course Level 1 which is self-explanatory.

The participation of both public and private school shall be on a voluntary basis. As such, the participants themselves shall shoulder any registration fees and travel/incidental expenses. Further, their participation shall be subject to the no-disruption-of-classes policy stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 titled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance therewith, Section 3 of Republic Act No. 5546 (Policy on Contributions), and DepEd Order No. 66, s. 2017 (Policy on Off-Campus Activities).



I am Ian Gil Piencenaves, a Regional Development Officer for Southeast Asia under the Badminton Asia (BA) and Badminton World Federation (BWF), In charge of implementing Shuttle Time, a Badminton School Program designed for Teachers and Coaches in schools.

In this regard, I would like to invite the Department of Education teachers to take part in Shuttle Time Malaybalay, *September 13-14, 2022 and BWF Coaching Course Level 1 on September 15-20, 2022* at *Malaybalay Badminton Center*. Program will start at 8:00 am. A School Badminton Program specifically designed for teachers to plan and deliver fun and safe badminton activities.

Teachers play a big role in introducing badminton to young kids and starting them to become interested and try the sport. However, a standardized skills development curriculum taught in a fun and age appropriate manner is yet to be implemented in the school level to ensure accuracy of learning the fundamental movement of the sport.

The international certification course program was developed and implemented by Badminton World Federation (BWF), and supervised by the Badminton Asia. An official event by the Philippine Badminton Association, Smash Pilipinas, we are aiming to deliver positive, fun and safe learning of badminton in school. This is our way of supporting and increasing the number of teachers who will deliver Shuttle Time to their respective schools in the Philippines.

Shuttle Time will train teachers and coaches to become confident in teaching Badminton in schools or handling children in sport. At the end of the 2-day seminar for Shuttle Time and 7 days for Coaching Course Level 1, participants will receive certificate from Shuttle Time, BWF and BA, a teacher Manuel, ready Lesson Plan, 92 Instructional videos supporting the exercises and Certificate for Coaching Course Level 1.

The course will be charging *P 2,500 for Shuttle Time and P 7,000 for BWF Coaching Course Level 1,* each participant will be covered by Lunch, Snacks, Shuttle Time Shirt, Printing of Teachers Manual and the Plan.

Together, we can help young Filipinos to excel in sports and contribute positively to our society. Thank you ang hoping for a positive and favorable response.
