

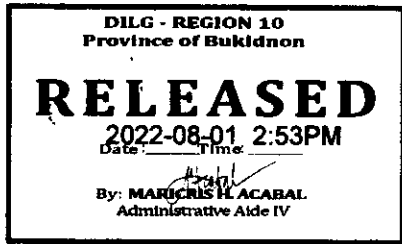

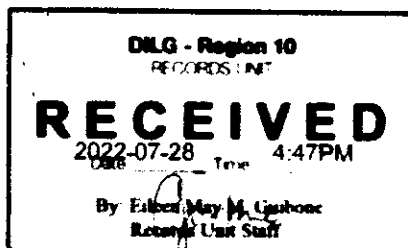

DATE : JUL 28, 2022

Background

- 1.1. Pursuant to Department of Education (DepEd) Order No. 034, series of 2022, issued on July 11, 2022 by Vice President and DepEd Secretary Sara Z. Duterte, School Year (SY) 2022-2023 shall formally open on Monday, August 22, 2022 and shall end on July 7, 2023.
- 1.2. In preparation for the opening of the School Year, the DepEd will implement *Brigada Eskwela* or the National Schools' Repair and Maintenance Period, an annual activity where everyone in the school community and the private sector work together to prepare schools for the opening of the classes. The DepEd also convenes concerned

agencies through the *Oplan Balik Eskwela* to ensure the safe and orderly start to the School Year.

- 1.3. According to the Calendar of Activities published by the DepEd through Order No. 034, the *Brigada National Kick-off* shall be on August 1, 2022, and the *Oplan Balik Eskwela Command Conference* shall commence on August 15, 2022.
- 1.4. In a Public Health Advisory issued on May 27, 2022, the Department of Health (DOH) sought to remind the general public of the benefits of face-to-face schooling for children.
 - 1.4.1. Face-to-face attendance in school will allow children to develop their cognitive and social skills experientially as it promotes physical and mental health and well-being.
- 1.5. In line with the aforementioned DepEd Order, all public and private schools shall transition to five (5) days in-person classes starting November 2, 2022.

Purpose

- 2.1. This Memorandum Circular shall enjoin LGUs and concerned operating arms of the Department in helping ensure the smooth implementation of the *Oplan Balik Eskwela* of the DepEd for the opening of SY 2022-2023.

Scope/ Coverage

- 3.1. All concerned Local Chief Executives, OIC of the Philippine National Police (PNP), Chief of the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) and the Bureau of Jail Management and Penology (BJMP), DILG Regional Directors, Provincial Directors, City and Municipal Directors, and others concerned.

Policy Content and Guidelines

4.1. General Guidelines for Local Government Units

- 4.1.1. LGUs shall continue to strictly enforce minimum public health standards within their areas of jurisdiction, particularly in schools where in-person classes shall be conducted.
- 4.1.2. LGUs shall coordinate with their local Philippine National Police (PNP) to ensure the orderly commencement of classes.
- 4.1.3. LGUs shall coordinate with the DepEd, the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH), and other relevant agencies to conduct building inspections and ensure the quality and structural integrity of school facilities.

- 4.1.4. The LGUs, through their LSBs, and pursuant to Section 100(c)(1) of the Local Government Code of 1991, are encouraged to utilize the Special Education Fund (SEF) and give priority to the construction, repair, and maintenance of school buildings and other facilities of public elementary and secondary schools. Said works shall ensure that these facilities conform with the standards set by the DOH for the prevention and mitigation of the spread of COVID-19, including on ventilation, physical distancing, provision of sanitation facilities, and other related engineering controls.
- 4.1.5. LGUs shall ensure that private schools and educational institutions operate with the necessary permits and licenses.
- 4.1.6. LGUs shall also ensure the placement of measures for the prevention of the outbreak of dengue fever.
 - 4.1.6.1. This may be done through intensifying the conduct of clean-up drives, and mobilizing volunteer residents, Barangay Health Workers (BHWs), Barangay Health Emergency Response Teams (BHERTs), and Barangay Public Safety Offices (BPSO)
 - 4.1.6.2. LGUs shall also conduct information campaigns relative to the frequently asked questions about the infection of dengue fever, its sources and causes, as well as the appropriate preventative measures.
- 4.1.7. LGUs, through the barangays and their BPSOs, shall ensure proper traffic management and that road networks leading to schools are secure, clean, and free from any obstructions and hindrances which may pose danger to and deter the passage of students.
- 4.1.8. Higher LGUs are called to supervise, assist, and if necessary, collaborate with their component LGUs. Provincial governments shall extend assistance to their component cities and municipalities and ensure the latter's adequate preparation for the opening of the School Year and resumption of face-to-face classes. Likewise, city and municipal governments are to convene and assist their respective barangays for the same purpose.
- 4.1.9. LGUs shall also continue their respective COVID-19 pediatric vaccination campaigns in accordance with existing DOH and DepEd guidelines.
- 4.2. **Guidelines for the PNP, BFP, and BJMP**
 - 4.2.1. The PNP, BFP, and BJMP shall fully assist in the implementation of DepEd's *Oplan Balik Eskwela*.

- 4.3.1. The DILG Regional Offices shall provide technical coordination to ensure compliance of LGUs within their jurisdiction to the appurtenant provisions herewith
- 4.3.2. The DILG Regional Offices shall provide assistance to LGUs in implementing the same directives; and
- 4.3.3. The DILG Regional Offices shall cause widest dissemination of this Memorandum Circular to inform the concerned LGUs within their respective jurisdictions.

5. Repealing Clause

All DILG orders and other issuances inconsistent herewith are hereby superseded, repealed and/or modified accordingly.
