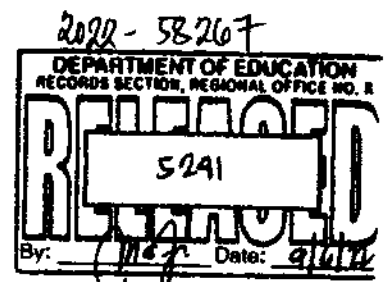

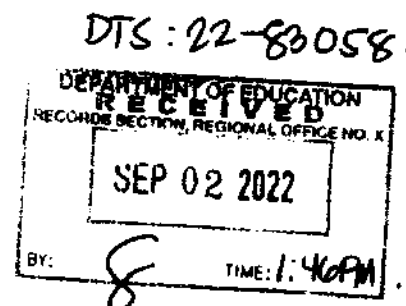
1. Make its strategic framework gender-responsive;
