SUBJECT: 2022 INTERNATIONAL CLEAN-UP DRIVE

1. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines -Bukidnon Council will join the **2022 International Clean-Up Drive** on **September 17, 2022**.

This year's International Clean Up will be celebrated on September 17, 2022, which aims to engage people around the world to remove trash and debris from waterways and other water bodies; to identify the sources of water debris, to change behaviors that cause pollution and to raise awareness on the extent of the water problem.
