

- 1. Open to all 10-15 years old children who are residents of the City of Malaybalay
- 2. Theme: "Kalusugan, Kaisipan, at Kapakanan ng Bawat Bata Ating Tutukan."
- 3. The video file to be submitted should be in:
 - a. Format: MP4, MOV, or WMV only
 - b. Time limit: minimum of four (4) minutes and a maximum of six (6) miunutes.
 - c. Language: May be in English, Tagalog, Bisaya, or Binukid (with subtitles)
- 4. The video must be an original work of the participant. Short clips from Youtube and Facebook are allowed. However, credits to the owner should be clearly stated.
- 5. Deadline for submission will be on November 18, 2022, 5:00 PM
- 6. Video entry shall be sent to imalaybalay.8700@gmail.com and once submitted, participant must call or text 09171352831 for confirmation of receipt.
- 7. Upon submission of the entry, the participants must provide the following information:
 - a. Title of Entry

d. Age

b. Name of Participant

e. Address

c. School Representing, if applicable

- f. Contact Number
- 8. All entries are subject to initial screening and should not contain any inappropriate language, image content
- 9. Entries which passed the inistial screening will be posted in the City Government of Malaybalay Official FB Page.

Content and Organization (40%)

• The content includes a clear statement of purpose or theme and is creative, compelling and clearly written. A rich variety of supporting information is present in the video which contribute to better understanding of the main idea. Events and messages are presented in a logical order and adhere to time limit, language, and format.

Production Quality (30%)

- The film is edited with high-quality shots. Video moves smoothly from shot to shot and a variety of transitions are used to assist in communicating the main idea and smooth the flow from one scene to the next. Shots and scenes flow seamlessly and digital effects are used appropriately for emphasis.
- The audio is clear and effectively assists in communicating the main idea. Actors communicate ideas with enthusiasm, proper voice projection, appropriate language, and clear delivery. Background audio is kept in balance and does not overpower the primary audio.

Creativity and Originality (20%)

• The film uses imaginative ways to convey the theme and displays innovative ideas in the telling techniques. It also exhibits originality and strongly invoke emotional response and stimulate thoughts and ideas. Sources of borrowed ideas and statistics are clearly cited.
