- 1. Anent to the *Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No.* 11510 (Alternative Learning System Act) and Regional Memorandum No. 45 s. 2013 re: Institutionalization of ALS Learning Camp, this Office hereby conducts the 2022 ALS Learning Camp on December 13-15, 2022, at Malaybalay City Community Learning Center, Barangay 1, Malaybalay City.
- 2. The activity aims to train learners on disaster preparedness and survival. It also aims to strengthen participation of learners in purposive activities that will promote development of life-long learning, intrapersonal and interpersonal intelligences and develop learner's positive values and attitudes through healthy competition and sports activities.
- 3. Participants to the said activities are ALS Learners (12 pax per district). And ALS Teachers will serve as chaperons, committee members and support staff.
- 4. Each district is required to bring their camping materials such as camping tents, emergency light, 1 roll of twine, bolo and other necessary materials for camping.
- 5. Learner participants should submit a parent/guardian's permit before they will be allowed to join the camp.
