**CALL FOR NOMINATIONS TO THE SEAMEO INNOTECH COURSES  
UNDER THE NATIONAL EDUCATORS ACADEMY OF THE PHILIPPINES  
(NEAP) PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS (PHASE 2)**

1. In keeping with its commitment to giving full support to the in-service professional development of teachers and school leaders to ensure quality basic education for all as stipulated in DepEd Memorandum No. 082 s. 2020, the Department of Education (DepEd), through the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP), announces its **Call for Nominations to the SEAMEO INNOTECH Courses under the NEAP Professional Development Programs (PDPs)** for teachers and school leaders.

2. These PDPs form part of the strategic program for the upskilling and reskilling of public school teachers and school leaders by giving them access to a wide range of NEAP-recognized professional development programs and courses that are integrated, aligned to the Philippine Professional Standards for Teachers (PPST), Philippine Professional Standards for School Heads (PPSSH), and Philippine Professional Standards for Supervisors (PPSS), and supportive of their career progression.

3. Moreover, as clearly expressed in the scholar's NEAP PDD Contract, chosen nominees/scholars shall "maintain the academic standards and other course requirements set for by the program. Otherwise, scholars need to refund in full to DepEd such sums of money as may have been defrayed by the Philippine government for expenses incidental to having attended the program or course, for failure to comply with any of the foregoing conditions."
