SUBJECT:

REITERATION OF THE SAFETY GUIDELINES FOR OUR LEARNERS,

TEACHERS, AND NON-TEACHING PERSONNEL DURING TYPHOON OR

HEAVY RAINFALL LEADING TO FLOODS

- 1. This Office reiterates its instruction to Schools to ensure the safety of all its learner, teachers, and non-teaching personnel during typhoon or even heavy rainfall that can lead to floods. Refer to Division Memorandum No. 580, s. 2022 re: Disaster Preparedness, Prevention, and Mitigation Measures for the Rainy Season and DepEd Order No. 37, s. 2022 re: Guidelines on the Cancellation or Suspension of Classes and Work in Schools in the Event of Natural Disasters, Power Outages/Power Interruptions, and Other Calamities.
- 2. In addition, this Office instructs all School Heads to follow the crafted learning continuity plan and to ensure that schools can easily shift to modular distance learning by having modules, projects, and/or performance tasks readily available should classes be suspended.
- 3. Furthermore, database of all learners who need to cross rivers or other bodies of water that may expose them to threats during heavy rainfall.
