SUBJECT: REITERATION OF THE SAFETY GUIDELINES FOR OUR LEARNERS, TEACHERS, AND NON-TEACHING PERSONNEL DURING TYPHOON OR HEAVY RAINFALL LEADING TO FLOODS

1. This Office reiterates its instruction to Schools to ensure the safety of all its learner, teachers, and non-teaching personnel during typhoon or even heavy rainfall that can lead to floods. Refer to Division Memorandum No. 580, s. 2022 re: Disaster Preparedness, Prevention, and Mitigation Measures for the Rainy Season and DepEd Order No. 37, s. 2022 re: Guidelines on the Cancellation or Suspension of Classes and Work in Schools in the Event of Natural Disasters, Power Outages/Power Interruptions, and Other Calamities.
2. In addition, this Office instructs all School Heads to follow the crafted learning continuity plan and to ensure that schools can easily shift to modular distance learning by having modules, projects, and/or performance tasks readily available should classes be suspended.
3. Furthermore, database of all learners who need to cross rivers or other bodies of water that may expose them to threats during heavy rainfall.
