RECONSTITUTING THE GENDER AND DEVELOPMENTY FOCAL POIN SYSTEM-EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF MALAYBALAY AND PROVIDING FOR ITS TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP

WHEREAS, Section 37, Rule XI of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA 9710 or The Magna Carta of Women Act of 2009 states, among others, that all Local Government Units (LGUs) shall pursue the adoption of gender mainstreaming as a strategy to promote and fulfill women's human rights and eliminate gender discrimination in their systems, structures, policies, programs, processes, and procedures;

WHEREAS, the same IRR also states that all LGUs shall establish or strengthen their Gender and Development Focal Point System (GFP) or a similar GAD mechanism through the establishment of an executive committee and a technical working group (TWG) or secretariat;

WHEREAS, the GFP Executive Committee was reconstituted on March 16, 2021 through Executive Order No. 132, Series of 2021;

WHEREAS, there is a need to amend the various special bodies and committees of the City Government of Malaybalay to make them more responsive to the new priorities and thrusts of the new administration;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JAY WARREN R. PABILLARAN, City Mayor of Malaybalay City, Bukidnon by the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the reconstitution of the GFP Executive Committee and providing for its Technical Working Group:



SECTION 2. Composition of the GFP Technical Working Group.

SECTION 3. Duties and Responsibilities. The GPF Executive Committee and the Technical Working Group shall perform duties and responsibilities in accordance with RA 9710 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations and other pertinent issuances.

The GFP Executive Committee shall likewise perform the duties and responsibilities provided under Executive Order No. 14, Series of 2017.

SECTION 4. Designation of GAD Coordinator. The heads of offices of the City Government of Malaybalay shall designate a Gender and Development Coordinator through an Office Order.

SECTION 5. Automatic Assumption. Should any member of the Committee or the Technical Working Group cease to hold his/her office by reason of permanent incapacity, removal, resignation or the likes, the person who succeed or appointed in the particular office/position shall automatically become a member thereof.

SECTION 6. Repealing Clause. All issuances or any part thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Executive Order are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 7. Effectivity. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
