





#### Additional Guidelines for Radio Scriptwriting and Broadcasting

Broadcast Simulation/recording the output

- 1. Each division shall prepare a broadcast room or recording studio for the presentation and for the recording of the simulation. Only the contestants and the members of the contest committee shall be allowed inside.
- 2. The division shall commission an independent sound system provider to ensure quality audio output. The technical operator shall only set the sound system before the simulation.
- 3. Except for the volume meter, contestants/technical director shall not be allowed to change, adjust, and manipulate the main control board during their presentation.
- 4. Reference books shall not be allowed in the contest area.
- 5. In case of power failure, the affected team shall be allowed to perform again.
- 6. It is allowed during the simulation/recording the use of the following:
  - a. Maximum of four wired or wireless dynamic microphones only.
  - b. One (1) self-amplified /powered speaker and/or maximum of two (2) passive speakers connected to a mixer with amplifier
  - c. A jack/auxiliary cord/adapter for the laptop/s to be used.
  - d. A recording device such as smartphone, iPhone, or laptop with recording software to record the final output during the broadcast simulation.
  - e. Any MP3 converter software using one of the devices indicated above.
- 7.Each team shall be given eight (8) minutes: two (2) minutes of which for preparation, five (5) minutes for the actual broadcast and one (1) minute for exit.
- 8. The MP3 output must have a quality not lower than 320kbps. In accordance with the copyright laws, music used in any entry must be original, licensed or in the public domain.

#### Additional Guidelines for TV Scriptwriting and Broadcasting

1. The TV Broadcast must be delivered in six minutes and must be canned (MP4, 1080p) with file name TV\_Division\_English/Filipino to be saved in the official regional flash drive.
