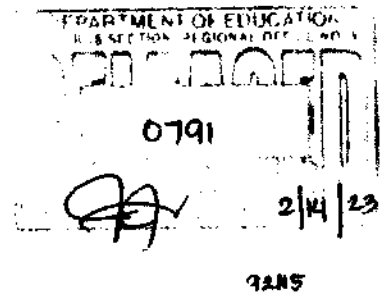

**FREE OPEN ONLINE BRIDGE COURSES FOR SENIOR  
 HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS**

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. This Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), in partnership with the Ugnayan ng Pahinungod UP Open University will offer massive online courses to select Grade 11 and 12 students. There are three bridge courses offered with the date of offering and duration. For Bridge Math, it will be on March 20-May 15, 8 weeks. Bridge English, April 10-May 8, 4 weeks, and Bridge Physics on March 20 to May 29, 2023, 6 weeks. Hence, select students could avail of all subjects offered and choose subjects they want to upgrade.
2. These bridge courses are free of charge and aim to address the learning loss and supplement the learning needs of our senior high school students. And prepare them for UPCAT and other related college entrance examinations.

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**UPOU ONLINE PROGRAM DETAILS**

**A. Objectives / Bridging Program**

1. To offer a massive open Online Bridge Program to select Senior High School (SHS) Grades 11 and 12 students of DepEd Region X on the following bridge courses with their dates of offering and duration:

Bridge Course	Date of Offering	Duration
Bridge Mathematics	March 20-May 15	8 weeks
Bridge English	April 10-May 8	4 weeks
Bridge Physics	April 17-May 29	6 weeks

2. To supplement the learning needs and learning losses of the students.
3. To prepare the SHS students to pass the UPCAT and other related College Entrance Examinations.

**B. Specific Details**

1. There are 800 slots available per course. Students may choose to enroll in up to three bridge courses depending on their resiliency and eagerness to finish the course/s.
2. The Schools Division Offices' (SDOs) focal person shall be the Division Math EPS. Likewise, the SDOS shall identify one school and its corresponding school focal person.
3. The role of the school focal persons:
  - a. Provide a complete list of enrollees and their corresponding profiles.
  - b. Arrange a conducive setup for asynchronous learning.
  - c. Arrange face-to-face plenary synchronous sessions for students.
  - d. Provide updates/concerns regarding the program offerings.
