Subject: **DEPLOYMENT OF TEACHING INTERNS FOR THE SCHOOL YEAR 2022-2023 FROM SAN ISIDRO COLLEGE SCHOOL OF EDUCATION**

1. In consonance with **DepEd Order No. 42, s. 2017** re: *Guidelines for the implementation of the Philippine Professional Standards for Teachers (PPST)*. This Office informs the School Heads of the identified schools on the deployment of Teaching Interns from San Isidro College School of Education from **March 6, 2023 to May 5, 2023**.
2. To attain the provision of Quality Teacher Education under the PPST, teaching internships are considered a critical component of teacher preparation thus Pre-service teachers are expected to undergo supervised teaching internships in real classroom settings, which provide them with opportunities to apply the knowledge and skills they have acquired in teacher education programs. During teaching internships, pre-service teachers are expected to demonstrate the following competencies:
 - Content and pedagogical knowledge
 - Planning, assessing, and reporting
 - Community engagement and professional development
 - Learning environment and student well-being
 - Diversity and inclusion
 - Communication and collaboration

Further, school heads in participating secondary schools shall ensure that **Teaching interns shall teach their major field and assigned to a cooperating teacher of the same specialization**.


