ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Microsoft Youth Ambassador is a pioneer program initiative of DepEd and Microsoft Philippines. It aims to enable Filipino learners to empower themselves and their fellow youth to thrive and excel in this technology-driven world. Furthermore, it aims to continue the legacy of the successful MYA pioneers.

Vision: An empowered Filipino student population who employ globally competitive skills and embodies the ideals of being value driven, career-oriented, culturally rooted and socially responsible

Mission: Create a pro-active and empowered community of Filipino learners who champion the use and adoption of technology to fellow students in the Philippines.

A. Benefits of the MYA 2.0 Program

- a. Skill development: Technology is an ever-evolving field, and Microsoft can help young people develop essential tech skills through workshops, training sessions, and hands-on experiences. This can increase their employability and prepare them for future careers.
