EMPLOYMENT OF STUDENTS (SPES) UNDER THE PROGRAM
OF DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT-**

WHEREAS, Section 13, Article II of 1987 Philippine Constitution mandates that the *"State recognize the vital role of the youth in nation-building and shall promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual, and social well-being, it shall inculcate in the youth patriotism and nationalism, and encourage their involvement in public and civic affairs";*

WHEREAS, Section 16, of Republic Act 7160 otherwise known as the **"Local Government Code of 1991"** provides that *"the Local Government Unit shall ensure and support, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balance ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of the inhabitants";*

WHEREAS, Section 2, of Republic Act 8759 otherwise known as "**Public Employment Service Office Act of 1999**" provides that it is "*the policy of the State to promote full and equality of employment opportunities for all, to strengthen and expand the existing employment facilitation service machinery of the government particularly at the local levels*";

WHEREAS, SPECIAL PROGRAM FOR EMPLOYMENT OF STUDENTS (SPES) focus on providing to the poor but deserving students whose parents combined income together with their own, if any, does not exceed the annual regional poverty threshold level for a family of six (6) for the preceding year as may be determined by the National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA). Thus, **SPES** is a program under the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) which empower students and out of school youth to acquire skills, enhancing their capabilities and gain work experience while earning income to support their studies;

WHEREAS, the Provincial Government of Bukidnon has been actively pursuing measures to eliminate unemployment, decrease the poverty threshold and promote economic development to build stronger communities by empowering people with access such as SPES that provides them a sense of purpose;

WHEREAS, Section 468, paragraph 4 (iii) of Republic Act 7160, "*provides the power and functions of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan as the legislative body of the province, to adopt measures which ensure the efficient and effective delivery of basic services for the establishment and operation of vocational and technical schools and similar post- secondary institutions for the poor but deserving students in schools located within its jurisdiction of for students residing within the province subject to the availability of funds and existing laws, rules and regulations*";

WHEREFORE, on motion of Board Member Mario Jr. B. Albarece, and unanimously seconded by all Sangguniang Panlalawigan Members present, in session assembled:

BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, **URGING ALL 15-25 YEAR OLD STUDENTS, DEPENDENTS OF DISPLACED OR WOULD BE DISPLACED WORKERS AND OUT OF SCHOOL YOUTH TO FILE AN APPLICATION AT THEIR NEAREST PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT SERVICES OFFICE TO BE A PART OF SPECIAL PROGRAM FOR EMPLOYMENT OF STUDENTS (SPES) UNDER THE PROGRAM OF DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT.**


