

1. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines Bukidnon Council, BSP is pleased announce of sending contingent to the 17th National Scout Jamboree on 11-17 December 2023 at Passi City, Iloilo, with the Theme: "Youth engagement: Sustaining Relevance and Strengthening Resilience"

2. This year's most awaited National Scout Event happens only every four (4) years nationwide with some special participation from other National Scout Organization from other countries.

Scouting is a global and educational youth Movement that builds friendships, experiences, and skills for life, shaping young people's future as active citizens. Through its unique combination of education, adventure and fun, Scouting continues to be an inspiration for young people to become active citizens who are engaged in creating a better and more sustainable world.

A scout Jamboree is the "Mother of all Activities" of a Scout's life, something every dedicated Scout and even Scout Leaders looks forward to and whose memories are cherished deeply afterward.

- 3. Aims and Objectives: The National Scout Jamboree aims to provide progressive, exciting, challenging, safe and enjoyable learning environment for the Scouts in order to enhance their physical, intellectual, character, emotional and spiritual potentials. As an active citizen making real contribution in creating a better community At the end of the Jamboree, the participants should be able to:
 - 1. Promote the Scouting's highest quality standards of educational initiatives that is faithful to the vision, mission, fundamental principles and methods of Scouting and adapted to the needs and aspirations of young people, one that is faithful to the mission, principles and method of Scouting and adapted to the needs and aspiration of young people
 - 2. Undertake high-adventure and outdoor activities, that promotes active and healthy lifestyle and appreciation of nature and environment);
 - Complete and satisfy the requirements for selected Merit Badges and Scout Ranks under the revised Advancement Scheme and Merit Badge System;
 - 4. Increase the level of awareness and understanding about the prevailing issues on environment, human rights, mental health and well-being, education, culture and science and technology, through the Global Development Village, City of Science and Cross Roads of Cultures.
 - 5. Promote sustainable Development Goals and best practices through Module and Educational Initiatives in Scouting

- 4. Qualifications. The following are qualifications for all participating Scouts and Adult Leaders:
 - 1. Boy Scout and Senior Scout:
 - 1. Must be currently registered as Boy Scout or Senior Scout with a Troop or Outfit;
 - 2. Physically fit to undergo strenuous activities especially in the outdoors as certified by a licensed Physician;
 - 3. Must be at least nine (9) to twelve (12) years old for Boy Scouts;
 - 4. Must be at least thirteen (13) to eighteen (18) years old for Senior Scouts;
 - 5. Secure his/her Parent's/guardian's consent; and
 - 6. Must have his/her own camping gears and equipment
 - 2. Troop Leader and Outfit Advisor:
 - 1. Must be of good moral character;
 - 2. Must be currently registered as Troop Leader or Outfit Advisor:
 - 3. Must be Physically Fit as certified by a licensed Physician;
 - 4. Must be a graduate of a Basic Training Course for Troop Leader/Outfit Advisor;
 - 5. Preferably a Wood Badge Holder,
 - 6. Must have his/her own camping gears and equipment
- 5. A Registration fee of TWELVE THOUSAND PESOS (P12,000.00) is charge to every participant to cover cost of the following;

a.	Jamboree Fee	500.00
b.	Transportation	7,200.00
c.	Foods	3,000.00
d.	EMR Contingent Uniform	500.00
e.	Camp Development	300.00

4. Full Payment

- P5,000.00 November 29 to December 7, 2023

7. To exercise effective and efficient unit organization and management a ratio of One (1) Adult Leader for every Nine (9) Boy/Senior Scouts.
