



SUBJECT : REQUEST FOR A VIDEO RECORDING OF NATIONAL ANTHEM AND PRAYER FOR THE NATIONAL CHILDREN'S MONTH 2023

DATE : October 2, 2023

In keeping with the mandates of Republic Act No. 10661¹ declaring November of every year as National Children's Month, the Department of Education (DepEd) through the Learner Rights and Protection Office (LRPO) will conduct a Kick-Off Program to be broadcast online and scheduled on November 11, 2023.

Accordingly, as part of our shared commitment to upholding our learner's rights and ensuring their protection, the LRPO hopes to showcase the different regional offices, schools division offices, and schools nationwide. With this, we hope to seek assistance from the regional and division office's Public Assistance Unit (PAU) to record the singing of the national anthem in their respective offices and selected schools.

Moreover, as part of its mandate to ensure the functionality of the Child Protection Committees (CPC) in schools, may we request the PAUs to record a video of CPC members reciting a prayer, enclosed herein is a copy of the prayer (*Annex B*). The same may be translated into their local dialect with subtitles for reference.

Your active participation in this initiative will greatly contribute to the success of our National Children's Month celebration and the promotion of learner rights and protection. For assistance in identifying the CPC members, our LRP regional and division focal personnel may lend help in identifying the CPC members.

Annex 1. Instructions and Specifications for the Video Record

A. Instructions

a. National Anthem Video

- i. Kindly film the video inside the school or office premises;
- ii. As for videos taken in schools, please note that our learners' participation is subject to DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 or "No Disruption of Classes Policy";
- iii. For better video quality, kindly seek assistance from your respective Public Affairs Unit (PAU);
- iv. For submission of videos, please upload the video to the following Google Drive link: <https://tinyurl.com/National-Anthem-Vid> with the filename format: Region_National Anthem

b. Prayer Video

- i. The Regional LRP Focals will be responsible for determining the participants from schools, specifically those members of the Child Protection Committees for the recorded video;
- ii. The learner representatives may be drawn from different grade levels;
- iii. The decision regarding the number of CPC members to be invited is at their discretion;
- iv. As for the participation of learners, kindly observe DepEd's policy on no disruption of classes as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005;
- v. The assigned lines for each region may be recited in their own local dialect, provided that the sub-title will be included in the video for reference;
- vi. The subtitles should be in a format that is easy to read. Use a legible font, in contrasting color, and position them at the bottom of the video screen;
- vii. To ensure better quality of video, please seek assistance from the Public Affairs Unit (PAU);
- viii. Subsequently, kindly upload the video to the following Google Drive link: <https://tinyurl.com/PrayerVids> with the filename format: Prayer Line Number_Region

B. Specifications

- A. Video Resolution - Full HD - 1080 (1920x1080 pixels)
- B. Stabilization - Use a tripod or stabilizer to minimize camera shake, especially for handheld shots.
- C. Audio Quality - Use external microphones and audio recorders for clear, noise-free sound.
