

- All interested participants must submit a Letter of Intent and a Recommendation/Certification from the Principal as the Official Representative of the School and must be endorsed by the School District Supervisor.
- Deadline of submission of Letter of Intent will be on November ~~24~~, 2023 (Friday).
- Each Participant can only make one entry.
- White illustration board will be used by the participants.
- Poster can be made using pencil, crayon, watercolour, oil paint, etc.
The following materials will be provided by the organizers:
 - Illustration Board (¼ size)
 - 16 color oil pastel
 - Pencil

Participants may bring additional materials if needed.

- Photographs, wires, other 3D objects, print-outs won't be acceptable. It should be original and hand made.
- The Topic of poster and theme should be clearly mentioned at the Top Margin of the Poster.

THEME:

"HEALTHY, NOURISHED, SHELTERED: *Ensuring the Right to Life for All*"

- Poster should not contain any personal details like Name, Class, School etc. of the participants. These details should be mentioned in registration form only.
- Participants shall be given two (2) hours to complete their outputs.
- All entries shall be judged by a Board of Judges composed of,

- The Prizes shall be:

- Each Participant can only make one entry.
- White illustration board will be used by the participants.
- Collage can be made using pencil, crayon, watercolour, oil paint, etc., and shall be provided by the participants.
The following materials will be provided by the organizers:
 - Illustration Board (¼ size)
 - Scissors
 - Glue
 - Paper brights
 - Pencil

- Participants may bring additional materials if needed.
- The collage must interpret and emphasize the theme,

THEME:

"HEALTHY, NOURISHED, SHELTERED: *Ensuring the Right to Life for All*"

- Collage should not contain any personal details like Name, Class, School etc. of the participants. These details should be mentioned in the registration form only.
- Participants shall be given two (2) hours to complete their outputs.

 - Two (2) Members
- The decision of the Board of Judges shall be FINAL and IRREVOCABLE.
- The Prizes shall be:
