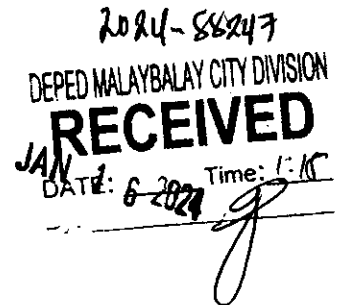


We humbly request your assistance to strengthen our partnership and conduct a blood donation activity on your preferred dates.
