- 1. In adherence to DepEd Order No. 10, s. 2016, this Office through the School Health Section informs the field on the **SUBMISSION OF WaSH IN SCHOOLS (WinS) PROGRAM MONITORING TOOL FOR SY 2022-2023 AND SY 2023-2024.** This program aims to ensure that all schools report and update their WinS status yearly with the use of the Three Star Approach (TSA). All School Heads are enjoined to intensify the implementation of SBM-WinS program by taking notice of the **WaSH IN SCHOOLS (WinS)** Program monitoring tool (See Enclosure 1).

It is also reiterated that schools shall focus on the five crucial points of the WaSH in Schools Program which are the following: PROVISION OF SAFE DRINKING WATER, DAILY GROUP HANDWASHING ACTIVITIES, AVAILABILITY OF GROUP HANDWASHING FACILITIES WITH SOAP, ACCESS TO SANITARY PADS, AND GENDER-SEGREGATED TOILETS in order to meet the standards of the Three Star Approach (TSA).
