## 22<sup>nd</sup> Year of Implementation of the City Government Scholarship Program of Malaybalay City


Enclosed is a letter from the Office of the City Mayor regarding the schedule of the qualifying exam for Malaybalay City Scholarship Program.

We are pleased to inform you that the Malaybalay City Scholarship Program is on its 22<sup>nd</sup> year of implementation. We have served 250 scholars yearly and will soon be proud of our 19<sup>th</sup> batch of college graduates.

The implementation of the City Government Scholarship Program is still focused on the City's declared policy to protect and promote the right of its constituents to quality education at all levels. Recognizing education as priority program, the City is thus establishing an access mechanism to tertiary education for its poor but deserving students thereby guaranteeing the completion of the college of at least one (1) member in each family in the city and ensuring their productive and meaningful participation in the society. It is aimed to provide college education to incoming 250 that belong to the low income group but deserving students.

## **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- A. The applicant must be a natural born Filipino citizen, of good moral character, and a resident of Malaybalay City;
- B. The applicant must not have any grade lower than (80%) percent in all subjects and with a General Average of (83%) during the preceding semester or school year at the time of application;
- C. The applicant must belong to a family whose gross family income does not exceed Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (Php 250, 000.00) per annum.
- D. The applicant, as well as his/her parents must be a registered voter of Malaybalay City;
- E. The applicant must be enrolled in a CHED and DepEd accredited government or private institution within the Province of Bukidnon;
- F. No two (2) or more members of the same family shall be allowed to enjoy the Scholarship Grant at the same time;
- G. The applicant must not be enjoying other scholarship award(s) educational grant (s), except those academic scholarship grants such as dean's lister given by their respective schools;

#### SCHOLARSHIP FOR TERTIARY STUDENTS Academic Scholarship

- A. Must be a graduate of a public or private senior high school.
- B. Must be a child of parents who are actually residing in the City of Malaybalay supported by a Certificate from the Barangay where parents are actually residing.
- C. Must be a senior high school graduate with a GPA (Grade Point Average) of at least 83% and with no grade below 80 per subject in grade 12.
- D. Must pass the qualifying competitive examination conducted by the City Government.
- E. Must pass the entrance examination of the State College or any school/college/university and enroll in any academic institution within the Province of Bukidnon.
- F. Must be not more than 25 years old at the time of application.
- G. Must be of good moral character, Certificate, must be issued by the Senior High School Principal.
- H. Must maintain a grade of not less than 2.75 per subject for regular scholars and 3.0 per subject for Indigenous People (IP) as final grades of the semester in any of the subjects taken.
- I. Scholar must enroll a full semestral load as prescribed in the approved course curriculum.
- J. Scholar must finish the course within (4) years.
- K. Shifting of course may be allowed after getting approval from the register and upon assessment and approval from the City Scholarship Program Coordinator, provided that student will carry a regular load of his/her new course,
