5. The qualifications of the delegates are the following:

- a) Senior scouts
- b) Must be currently registered
- c) Physically fit and/or in good health
- d) Must be in Grade 9, 10 & 11
- e) 15 to 17 years old based on the policy

6. A forum fee of **Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00)** only intended for snacks, meals and materials needed for the whole duration.

7. Youth Forum Fee for the participants is chargeable against local/PTA/School Board Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

5. A forum fee of FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (**P500.00**) ONLY for Snacks, Meals and Materials needed for the whole duration.
6. Youth Forum Fee for participants is chargeable to your Local Funds/School Board Funds (MOOE) subject to usual accounting and auditing process.
7. Forum will start at 9:00 O'clock in the afternoon of Friday March 08, 2024.
