c. Field Validation	April 3-5, 2024	This phase will involve pilot testing of the developed assessments. Engaging stakeholders, including educators and learners, is crucial in gathering valuable teedback to improve the assessments' effectiveness.	Face-to-Face
f. Finalization	April 24-26, 2024	In the final stages, this Office will conduct a thorough analysis of the data collected during the field validation. Based on the insights gained, revisions will be made to ensure the assessments' quality and efficacy. The final versions will be documented and prepared for dissemination.	Facc-to-Facc



- Regarding DepEd Order No. 55, s. 2016 on Policy Guidelines on the National Assessment of Student Learning for the K to 12 Basic Education Program, this Office, through the Curnculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), will conduct the Development of Assessment for Self-Learning Modules Aligned with Higher-Order Thinking Skills
- 2 Committed to enhancing the effectiveness of the self-learning modules, this Office is embarking on a commencesive journey to develop assessments that align with Higher-Order Thinking Skills (HOTS).
- 3 This Memorandum outlines a series of collaborative activities that arm to refine the existing modules and elevate the assessment process:
 - a. Online Meeting for Mapping and Preparation of the Budget of Work. To kickstart this initiative an online meeting is scheduled for January 30, 9:00 a.m., via Zoom. This gathering will bring together experts to discuss the mapping of competencies and preparation of the Budget of Work (BoW), setting the stage for the upcoming phases of development.
 - b. Mapping and Budget of Work Development. In the subsequent weeks, February 12-14, the focus will shift to a detailed review of the existing modules, brainstorning sessions to generate innovative ideas, and the development of a comprehensive BoW. This phase aims to provide a clear roadmap for the entire assessment development process.

- c Capacity Building on Test Development. Scheduled for February 26-27, this segment will comprise workshops and training sessions that will equip the test developers with the necessary skills to create assessments that specifically the target HOTS.
- d. **Test Development.** Scheduled for **February 28-March 1**, this segment will comprise writing sessions where team members will collaborate to draft assessment items reflecting targeted higher order thinking skills. Regular review sessions, alignment with learning competencies, and constant quality assurance measures will ensure the rehability and validity of the assessments.
- Field Validation. The field validation phase on March 6-8 will involve pilot testing of the developed assessments. Engaging stakeholders including educators and learners, is crucial in gathering valuable feedback to improve the assessments' effectiveness.
- Finalization. In the final stages scheduled for March 13-15, this Office will conduct a thorough analysis of the data collected during the head validation. Based on the insights gained, revisions will be made to ensure the assessments' quality and efficacy. The final versions will be documented and prepared for dissemination.
