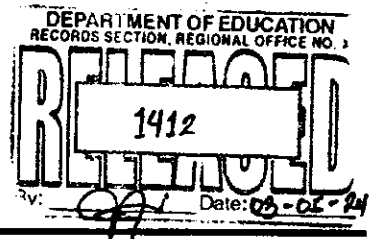

CONDUCT OF THE 2024 PALARONG PAMPOOK (NMRAA MEET)

To: Schools Division Superintendents
Assistant Schools Division Superintendents
SGOD Chiefs
Divisional Sports Officers
All Others Concerned

1. Following the Memorandum from the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Operations dated January 16, 2024, the 2024 Northern Mindanao Regional Athletic Association (NMRAA) Meet or *Palarong Pampook* will be hosted by the Provincial Government of Camiguin headed by **The Honorable Governor Xavier Jesus D. Romualdo** and to be cohosted by the Division of Camiguin on May 13-17.

- 2. This sports activity aims to
 - a. promote the holistic development of learners through provision of school sports opportunities to improve their physical, intellectual, and social well-being;
 - b. identify the qualified athletes to represent NMRAA in the *Palarong Pambansa* 2024 in Cebu City;
 - c. level up competition with focus sports and a lean-and-mean approach;
 - d. attain academic-sport life balance while promoting the value of sportsmanship; and
 - e. realize practically the essence of teamwork and camaraderie.

3. The 2024 NMRAA meet shall adopt the provisions set in the **Implementing Guidelines on the Modified Competition Format for the 2023 Palarong Pambansa** as enclosed in DepEd Memorandum No. 005, s. 2023 entitled Conduct of the 2023 *Palarong Pambansa*.

4. Further, the 2024 NMRAA meet shall continue to adopt the **Winner-Take-All** policy for all team sports (Basketball, Baseball, Softball, Football, Futsal, Sepak Takraw, and Volleyball).

5. The **Qualifying Standards** shall still be implemented in the 2024 *Palarong Pambansa*; but for 2024 NMRAA Meet, the Division Athletic Associations (DAAs) are still encouraged to send their best athlete-representatives for the measurable sports such as Athletics, Swimming, and Archery to give the winner-athletes in the Divisions with opportunities to prove their competence in the regional level and further subject themselves for qualification in the *Palarong Pambansa* awaiting the 2024 Technical Guidelines for *Palarong Pambansa* Events including the Qualifying Standards for Measurable Sports.

6. All schools are highly encouraged to organize their sports clubs featuring mandatory and/or sports where they excel. However, all qualified learner-athletes, whether part of the school sports club or not, shall be allowed to compete in the regional level up to *Palarong Pambansa* provided that they meet the eligibility requirements set forth in Rule V, Sections 19, 20, and 21 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 10588 otherwise known as the *Palarong Pambansa Act of 2013*, and the Guidelines on the Eligibility of Athletes (and its corresponding Amendments) set by the National, Regional, and Division Screening and Accreditation Committee of the *Palarong Pambansa* (DM Nos. 005, s. 2023 (Enclosure 2) and 035, s. 2023 (Enclosure 7)).
7. Moreover, the **clustering of small schools** stated in Section II. A (School Level Competitions), Item No. 3 of the Implementing Guidelines refers to the conduct of the competitions at the school level, specifically inter-sports club competitions as clearly specified in the provision.
8. The DepEd Child Protection Policy (DepEd Order 40, s. 2012) shall be fully adopted before, during, and after sporting events. The 2024 *Palarong Pampook* shall follow the safeguarding guidelines to minimize risk, guarantee safe space, and ensure positive experience for all delegates, organizers, and others who are involved in the event. Further, through the safeguarding guidelines, appropriate preventive, protective, and remedial measures will be properly implemented. Yet, a Child Protection Desk shall be fully operationalized through the Child Protection Committee (CPC) in all playing venues and billeting quarters.
9. The *Palarong Pampook* Host shall prepare a comprehensive DRRM and contingency plan in the duration of the event and identify the dates for the conduct of hazard drill orientation seminar and its implementation especially in the billeting quarters and playing venues. Moreover, the existing DepEd Order No. 37, s. 2022 titled "New Guidelines on the Cancellation or Suspension of Classes and Work in Schools in the Event of Natural Disasters, Power Outages/ Power Interruptions and Other Calamities" shall be fully implemented.
10. For the budgetary requirements, fund support to cover the *Palarong Pampook*-related expenses shall be downloaded to the host Division for the conduct of the event, charged to the Physical Fitness and School Sports Funds (Continuing and Current) of Central Office, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
11. The detailed information on the sports venues, billeting quarters, schedule of activities, and other provisions for the 2024 *Palarong Pampook* shall be released in the next regional issuance.
12. The specific guidelines of the games as provided in Section 27, Rule VI of the IRR of RA 10588 and the list of technical officials shall also be released in a separate issuance.

SUBJECT : **GENERAL INFORMATION ON THE CONDUCT OF THE 2024**
PALARONG PAMBANSA LOWER MEETS

DATE : 16 January 2024

The Department of Education (DepEd), in coordination with the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC) and the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG), shall conduct the **64th edition of the Palarong Pambansa** in Cebu City this year.

The conduct of all competitions leading to and including the national *Palarong Pambansa* such as the intramurals, division, and regional meets shall adopt the provisions set in the **Implementing Guidelines on the Modified Competition Format for the 2023 Palarong Pambansa** as enclosed in DepEd Memorandum (DM) No. 005, s. 2023 entitled *Conduct of the 2023 Palarong Pambansa*.

This year's *Palarong Pambansa* shall continue to adopt the **Winner-Take-All** policy for all team sports (Basketball, Baseball, Softball, Football, Futsal, Sepak Takraw and Volleyball) and the **Qualifying Standards** for measurable sports such as Athletics, Swimming, and Archery.

On the other hand, the *Palarong Pambansa* competition format shall no longer feature the **Pre-National Qualifying Meet (PNQM)** and shall be reverted to the

previous Pre-COVID 19 pandemic set-up (from the school competitions, division meet, regional meet, to the national *Palarong Pambansa*).

As a reiteration, all schools are encouraged to organize their respective sports clubs featuring mandatory and/or sports where their school excel at, in support to the Department's thrust of promoting the holistic development of learners through the proposed institutionalization of sports clubs in all public schools nationwide.

However, all qualified learner-athletes – may they be part of the school sports clubs or not – shall be allowed to compete in the *Palarong Pambansa* provided that they meet the eligibility requirements set forth in Rule V, Sections 19, 20, and 21 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 10588 otherwise known as the *Palarong Pambansa Act of 2013*, and the Guidelines on the Eligibility of Athletes (and its corresponding Amendments) set by the National, Regional, and Division Screening and Accreditation Committee of the *Palarong Pambansa* (DM Nos. 005, s. 2023 [Encl. 2] and 035, s. 2023 [Encl. 7])

Further, as a clarification, the *clustering of small schools* stated in Section II.A (School Level Competitions), Item No. 3 of the Implementing Guidelines refers to the *conduct of the competitions at the school level*, specifically inter-sports club competitions as clearly specified in the provision.

A DepEd Memorandum containing the **technical guidelines per sports, revised set of qualifying standards** (time, distance, and points) for measurable sports, and all other relevant information on the conduct of the 2024 *Palarong Pambansa* shall be issued on a later date.
